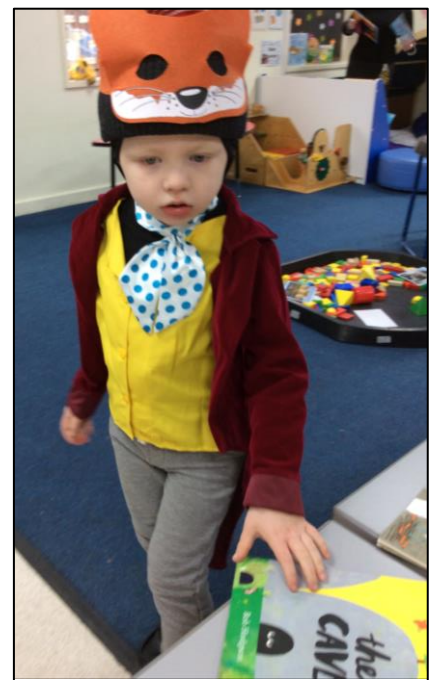
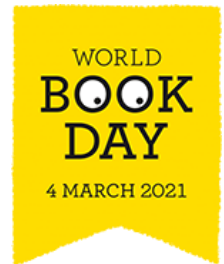


**World Book Day – Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> March**

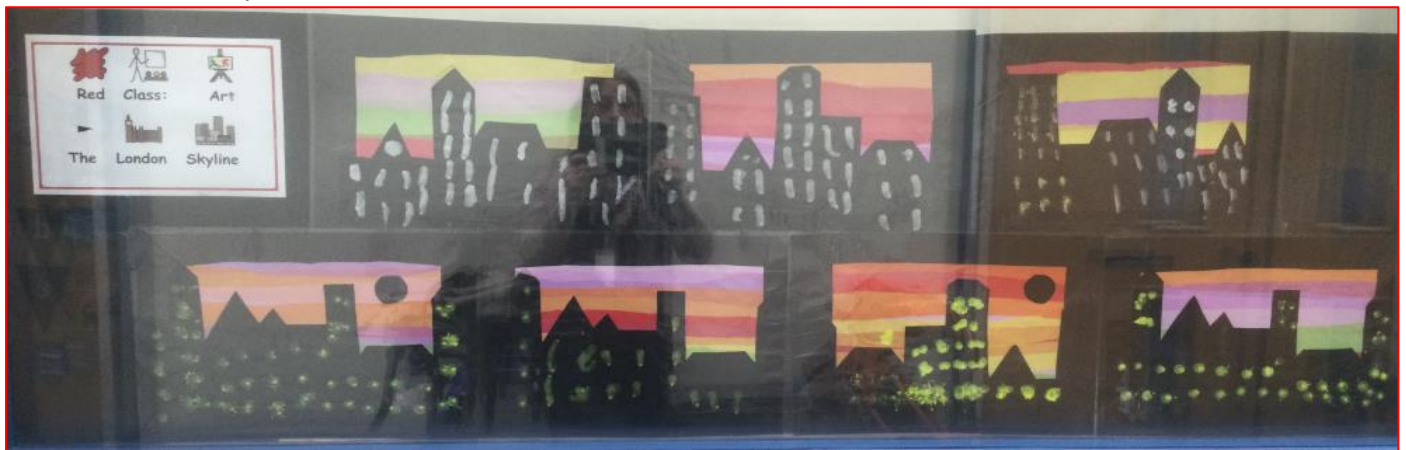
## Yellow Class
