If you decide you do not want to vaccinate your child against flu, please also complete the consent form giving the reason. You will need to enter the following code to ensure the completed form can be correctly allocated to your child's school. The code for Willoughby Academy is: EE120763. Flu vaccinations will be administered by NHS nurses on Thursday 8th October.
