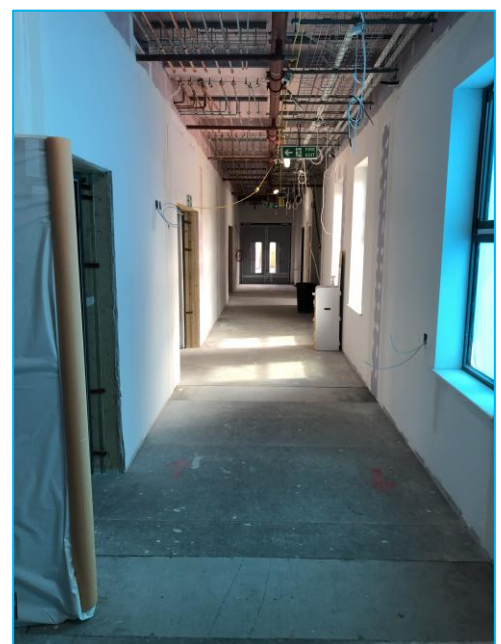


Pupil Medication Reminder
