

Guidance on face coverings at Willoughby

The guidance on face coverings in education has been amended. From Monday 17th May face coverings will no longer be recommended for pupils in classrooms or communal areas, in all schools and colleges. At Willoughby face coverings have not been mandatory for staff or pupils in classrooms, reflecting the needs of our pupils. Only in communal areas did we recommend the wearing of face masks for staff. This will no longer be the case as of Monday, with face coverings only recommended for staff if social distancing is not possible.

In addition to this, parents and carers are able to visit the school for pre-arranged visits or appointments.

Please be aware that the reintroduction of face coverings may be advised for a temporary period in response to particular localised outbreaks, including variants of concern.
