Citizens Advice Information – EU Settlement Scheme

Please refer to the attached posters for further information about the EU settlement Scheme. Deadline to apply is **30**th **June 2021.** Many EU Citizens believe that as their child has been born in the UK, it means that they do not have to apply for the EU Settlement Scheme as they are British citizens. Although in some cases this may be true, in many cases the child will not be a British citizen despite being born in the UK and will still need to apply.
