Price: £3.50 – full time carers and support workers are free (everyone attending must have a ticket)

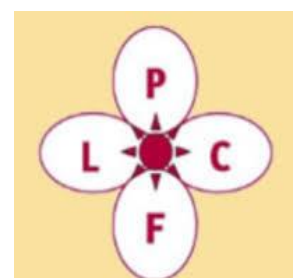
