Happy New Year! We hope you have had a relaxing and restful Christmas break. As you may well be aware, current Government guidance recommends that face coverings are worn in classrooms for pupils in year 7 and above. The advice is short term only, to support pupils and teachers as they return to school. This builds on the existing proportionate guidance that recommends face coverings for all adults in the communal areas of all settings.

We strongly encourage all pupils of secondary age to continue lateral flow testing twice weekly at home and to report all results to the NHS Test and Trace system.
