Covid-19 NHS Vaccination Letter

Lincolnshire Community Health Services will be visiting Willoughby Academy on **Thursday 10th February** to offer Covid vaccinations to children aged 12-15 years old. The NHS letter was e-mailed to parents/carers and a copy of the letter was sent home with your child earlier in the week. Please follow the link detailed in the letter and enter the code provided. Please provide consent at your earliest convenience as the online NHS system closes 48 hours prior to the visit. *Please note Covid vaccinations cannot be given to those within 12 weeks of testing positive for Covid-19 but can be given at any time interval with other childhood vaccinations.*

Peterborough Museum - Tulip Class

Tulip class had a wonderful first trip to Peterborough Museum on Tuesday. As part of our Habitats and Environments, Humanities and Science work, we went to see the Dinosaurs, Ice Age and First People galleries.
