The Christmas Card Recycle Challenge



Please can parents/carers be aware that there is a difference in the way over the counter (Calpol, Nurofen) and prescription only medication is administered in school.



The school is governed by legislation that protects children and young people. It is in place to ensure good practice and strict procedures - ensuring children and young people are not placed at a disadvantage when on medication, short or long term.

To help us continue to support pupils in this way can I please ask parents/carers to ensure that all medication - whether over the counter or prescribed is clearly labelled with the child's name and written permission is given and dated. Any prescription medication must have a pharmacy label showing, date of issue, dose and frequency of dose.
