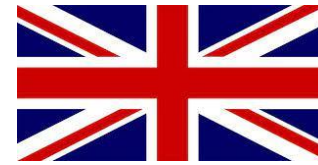
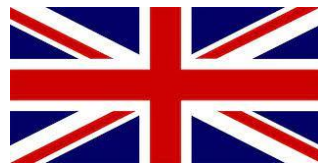
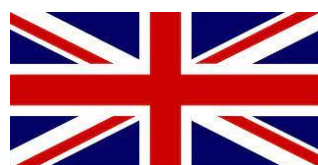
Tulip Class Trip
