

NSPCC - Talk PANTS with Makaton

The NSPCC have recently launched their new free resource for schools and parents- Talk PANTS with Makaton. These resources aim to help parents and teachers to talk to children with a range of needs about keeping safe from sexual abuse and have been created in partnership with the Makaton charity. NSPCC have adapted the wording of the 5 PANTS rules to make them easier to understand and talk about with Makaton symbols and signs.
