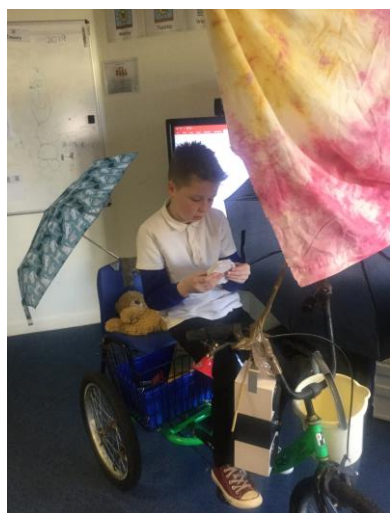




Yellow Class
