#### **Nut Free School**

We need to raise awareness that some of our pupils at Willoughby suffer from allergies. In particular allergies to nuts. People who suffer from nut allergies can develop a severe, potentially life-threatening allergic reaction.


If someone has a nut allergy, it is not just eating nuts that can cause a severe reaction. Being touched on the skin or smelling the breath of someone who has had nuts or a product containing nuts can trigger anaphylactic shock (which can cause breathing and swallowing difficulties). First aid staff in the school are trained to use the Epi-pens which are required immediately if this occurs. We cannot have nuts in school in any form. Please can we ask that you have no nut products in lunch boxes or brought into school. Example of nuts found in foods include:

- Peanut butter sandwiches
- Chocolate spreads
- Cereal bars
- Some granola bars
- Cakes that contain nuts
- Biscuits/cookies that contain nuts
- Peanut butter cakes
- Sauces that contain nuts

This list is not exhaustive. We understand that this is an additional thing to check, and we know that you will recognise the importance of taking such precautions. We appreciate that lots of parents send in snacks for their son/daughter, cakes on birthdays, this is still permitted, all we ask is you think 'Nut Free'
