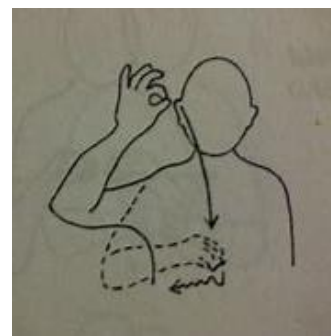


## Makaton Sign of the Week
