Beginning and end of school day arrangements

As I am sure you will all agree, the safety of our pupils is our highest priority. With the number of pupils attending Willoughby growing, so does the amount of traffic in and out of the school. This is particularly evident at the beginning and end of the school day. We try hard to ensure that pupil arrival and departure is as safe as possible. Transport is always supervised by a member of staff and the main gates are closed before pupils can enter or exit their transport. The main gates are only opened for transport to leave when it is safe to do so.

For those pupils being collected and dropped off by parents please ensure you always use the pedestrian gate - a member of staff will be there to let you in and out. Please could we ask parents who collect their child from school not to stand directly in front of the main entrance doors whilst waiting for your child as this can cause a little difficulty in getting our younger pupils on to transport. Please be assured that staff will bring your child to you as quickly as possible. We would also respectfully request that disabled spaces in the front carpark are left for parents who have children in wheelchairs. I am sure everyone can appreciate the need for the additional space to safely load and unload wheelchairs. Thank you for your help and support in this matter.
