
#### **Daffodil Class**

This week Daffodil class have been learning about Willoughby Values and have made a collage which is displayed in their classroom to help remind them of the values.




#### **National Careers Week**


Willoughby is delighted to be taking part in National Careers Week on the 6<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> March. During this week our aim is to

## Bourne2shine Coffee Morning - Friday 24th March


