**Cooking Lessons – By Alison Cavanagh**

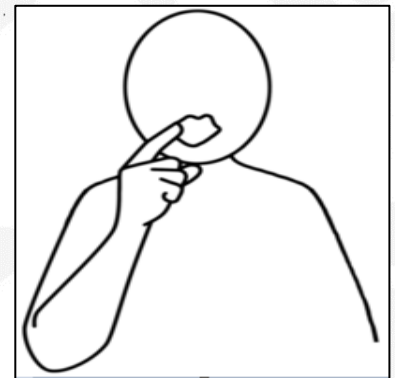
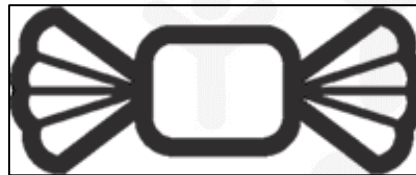
