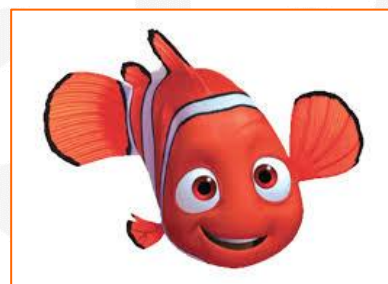

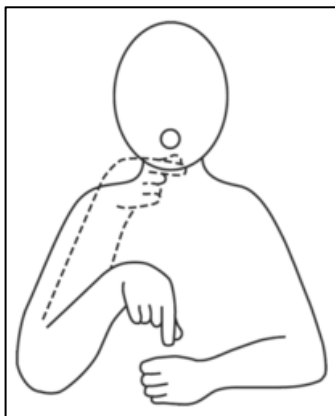
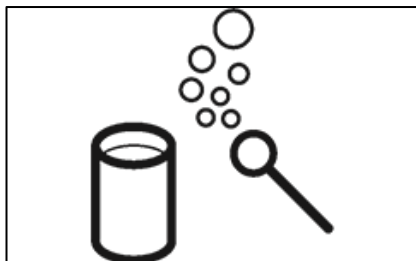
Ideal School Meals – Ordering Reminder

National Numeracy Day

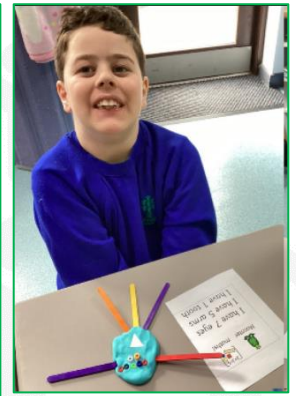
