For the school production 'Willoughby finds Nemo' your child will need:

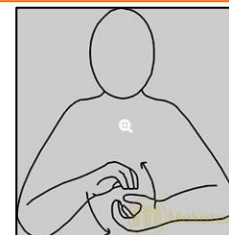

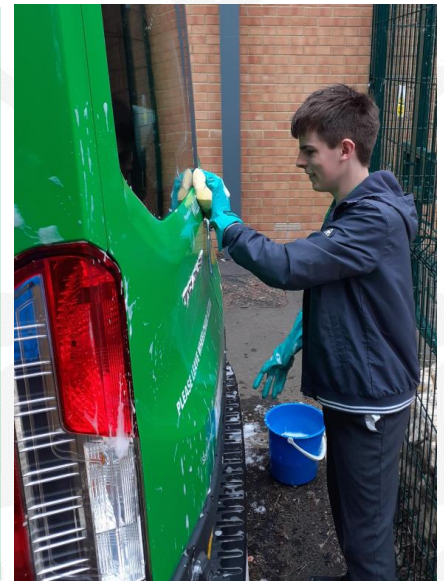
Protea Class
