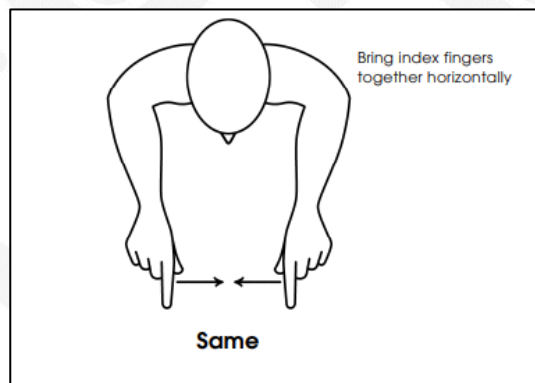


#### Whole School Attendance
