### Ofsted Pilot Inspection

On Tuesday and Wednesday, we welcomed two Ofsted Inspectors into school - Simon Hollingsworth and Lynda Morgan. They spent time with staff members, governors and pupils, observing a number of lessons and had detailed meetings with the Senior Leadership Team. The aim of the inspection was to test the new proposed Ofsted framework due to come into operation in September 2019. As a school, we also received verbal feedback regarding our current provision against the new framework.

I am delighted to say that the feedback we received was superb. The inspectors praised Willoughby's curriculum intent, implementation and impact, the effective safeguarding, the strong teaching and the progress pupils make through their learning. The inspectors were particularly praising of the very strong relationships between staff and pupils that supported learning and the high levels of care. They also highly commended pupils conduct and interaction throughout the inspection, noting that pupils wanted to achieve. Community interaction and involvement was also identified as a significant strength of the school. As a 'pilot' inspection, there will be no written report and our grading will remain as 'good' from our inspection in 2016.

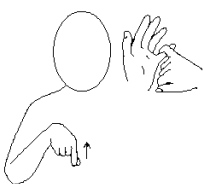
### Charity Cycle Ride
