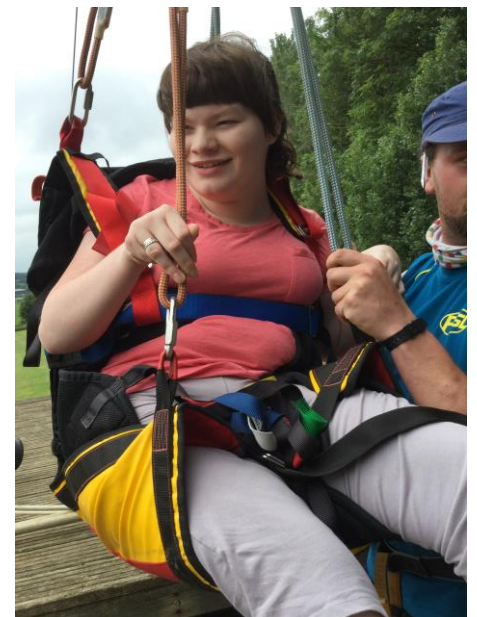




### **PGL Caythorpe Residential Trip Update**

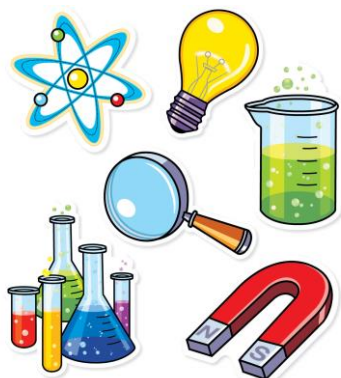
