During Term 4, whole school attendance figure was 91.2%. Congratulations to Gold, Yellow and Lilac classes for their attendance of 97% and above.

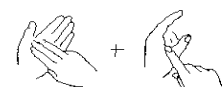
### Yellow Class topic 'Walk the plank'
