Curriculum

The theme for this term is ***You've Got a Friend in Me***. In English we explore this through our book *Charlotte's Web* by E.B. White. We will be discussing the friendship between Wilbur and Charlotte as a class and completing social writing tasks including informal emails and invitations. We will continue this topic in PSHE, exploring personal identity and looking at the different components that make up who we are, including how these influence our hopes and aspirations for the future.

In maths we are focusing on place value. We will be working in groups to explore different ways to segment and represent numbers. Our science topic this term covers animals and humans, with a particular focus on digestion. We will be conducting fun experiments to help us understand how different systems in our body function.

We will continue to have weekly cooking and art lessons with Alison and Lily.
