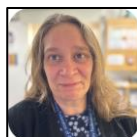

Curriculum

This term, during our Communication and Language lessons we'll be reading a couple of stories called 'The Jungle Book' and 'Roaming through the jungle'. We will also be continuing to work on our fine motor skills and learning about the structure of a sentence, as well as working on handwriting skills. We will also be learning new vocabulary each week.

In our Cognition and Learning lessons, some of us will be doing addition and subtraction, money and multiplication while the rest of us work more on our counting, matching and sorting skills.

During Science, we will be learning about habitats. We will group animals and also look at what a food chain is, as well as looking at the life cycle of animals.

In PSHE lessons, we will be answering the big question, *How can I manage my feelings?* We will be looking at the different types of emotions and different strategies we can use to support them.

As well as these core subjects, we'll be enjoying lessons in cookery, P.E., Life skills, Forest School, Dance and Art.
