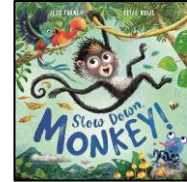

Curriculum

In English this term, our sensory story will be based on "slow down, monkey"; a lovely non-fiction text that will help us to continue to write Colourful Semantics sentences, including the use of adjectives, capital letters and full stops.

In Maths, we will be progressing onto using the knowledge learnt in term 1 around number, to begin to work on addition and subtraction. We'll also be thinking about using time and money within our daily lives, including the continuation of *Sycamore Shop*.

During Science lessons, we'll be thinking about animals and their habitats, linking to the animals within our sensory story.

Within PSHE lessons, we're going more in-depth into learning about our feelings, linking well with our ongoing emotional literacy work.

We're also excited to be continuing our dance sessions with Chloe this term and beginning our Forest School sessions with Dave!
