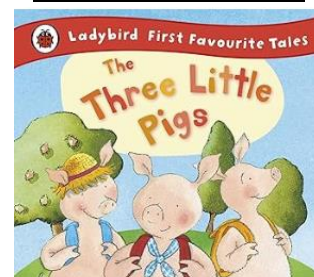

Curriculum

This term, during our Communication and Language lessons we'll be reading and exploring the story of 'The Three Little Pigs'. We will be retelling the story, looking at familiar phrases and comparing it to another story called 'The Three Little Wolves and The Big Bad Pig'. We will continue to work on our fine motor skills and will look at different types of punctuation we can use. Vocabulary will still be a key focus each week.

In our Cognition and Learning lessons, some of us will be doing multiplication and division while the rest of us work more on our counting, matching and sorting skills. We will all be looking at time too.

During Science, we will be learning about forces. This will be cross-curricular with our literacy story. We will be exploring friction, magnets, push and pull to name a few through various different experiments.

In PSHE lessons, we will be looking at how we can stay safe and look after ourselves.

As well as these core subjects, we'll be enjoying lessons in cookery, P.E., Life skills, Forest School and Art.
