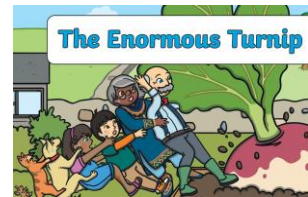

Curriculum

In English, our sensory story is 'The Enormous Turnip'. Through this engaging story, the children will be using hands-on activities to bring the book to life and continue to develop their sentence writing with Colourful Semantics.

Alongside our ongoing number work in Maths, we will be focusing on measurement. The pupils will explore length, height and weight, using practical activities to compare and measure objects.

In science, we will be learning more in depth about the seasons and exploring why they change throughout the year.

Our PSHE topic is self-care, support and safety. The pupils will be learning about looking after themselves, understanding who can help them, and staying safe.

In P.E., we will be developing teamwork skills while learning 'net' and 'wall' games.
