### Curriculum

This term, during our Communication and Language lessons we'll be reading and exploring the story of 'There's a tiger in the garden'. We will be making simple predictions, describing the characters and exploring the resources related to the story. We will also continue to work on our fine motor skills and will look at different types of punctuation we can use. Vocabulary will still be a key focus each week.

In our Cognition and Learning lessons, some of us will be learning time, length and weight, while the rest of us work more on our counting, and individual targets.

During Science, our topic is 'How does your garden grow?' This term we will be planting lots of seeds, in preparation for our garden and observing the changes that happen.

In PSHE lessons, we are looking at healthy lifestyles. We will explore how people can help us when we are feeling poorly or injured, investigate things that are safe/unsafe to swallow at home and name some things that we like/dislike.

As well as these core subjects, we'll be enjoying lessons in cookery, P.E., Life skills, Forest School, trampolining and Art.
