

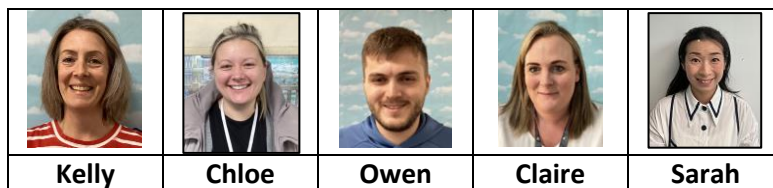

Our maths focus is money, with Kelly, and fractions, with Chloe. In money lessons we will continue to use all the addition, subtraction and multiplication skills we have learnt so far to find totals and change.

Our fractions learning will link back to the shape work we did earlier in the year.

Healthy Lifestyles is the focus of our PSHE learning and we will be thinking about what is happening to our bodies when we are ill, how we get better and how we keep our bodies clean and healthy.

This term we will be going for walks to different places in the community every Wednesday afternoon. Each visit will link to our curriculum learning.
