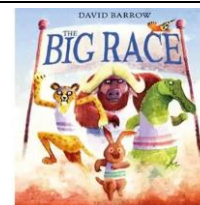

## Curriculum

This term, during our Communication and Language lessons we'll be reading and exploring the story of 'The Big Race'. We will be making simple predictions, describing the characters and exploring the resources related to the story. We will also continue to work on our fine motor skills and will continue to look at different types of punctuation we can use. This term we will also continue looking at and using prefixes and suffixes within our writing.

In our Cognition and Learning lessons, some of us will be learning ordinal numbers, capacity and shape, while the rest of us work more on our counting, and individual targets.

During Science, our topic is 'Weather'. This term we will be looking at the different seasons and how weather changes.

In PSHE lessons, we are working more on turn taking and sharing, as well as looking at who safe people are, what consent is and learning more about what private and public is.

As well as these core subjects, we'll be enjoying lessons in cookery, P.E., Life skills, Forest School, trampolining and Art.
