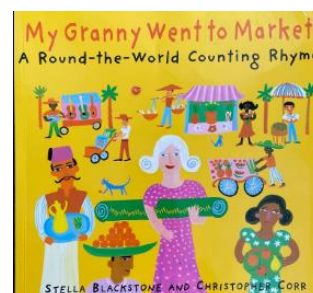


Welcome
