### Welcome

We finish off the academic year with welcoming Kerryn back after her operation. Our last term is filled with tons of activities from the Summer Fayre to our end of year trip. Our academic focus will remain the same as last term, as we continue to build on skills that we have already gained, and introduce additional ones that will challenge us.

### This term our book is...



This term builds on the important life skills we began developing last term and marks our final term of the academic year. We will continue to strengthen pupils' understanding of time, the local community and food safety. In the first half of the term, our focus will be on consolidating knowledge of analogue and digital time, including reading clocks, using AM and PM and applying these skills to everyday routines and simple timetables. We will encourage pupils to use these skills more independently as part of their daily learning.

Pupils will also continue exploring their local community, extending their understanding of local facilities such as shops, leisure spaces, and essential services. They will build on previous learning by planning routes and preparing for visits that are meaningful to them, supporting their confidence and independence in real-life situations. Alongside this, we will further develop pupils' knowledge of food hygiene. This includes reinforcing key skills such as effective handwashing, maintaining clean kitchen spaces, understanding food date labels and recognising when food is safe to eat. Practical, real-world activities will continue to play a key role in supporting independence.
