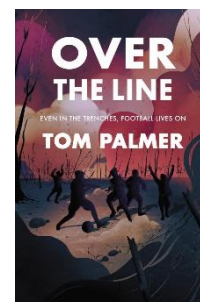

Welcome

We hope you enjoyed the sunshine over the half term holiday and are ready for this last term! This term is filled with end-of-year activities as we bring this academic year to a close and celebrate our achievements.

Curriculum

This term our cross curricular theme is **Ready, Steady, Go!** and will be the inspiration for everything we do. Our text is *Over The Line* by Tom Palmer this term as we look at the First World War and life in the trenches, sports such as football and signing up for the War. To compliment this, our focus genre is discussion. In our Literacy lessons we shall still work on key vocabulary, grammar and comprehension skills as usual.

In PSHE lessons we will be working on changing and growing including respectful relationships, consent and boundaries as well as different types of relationships. In Computing we shall be working in Microsoft Power Point, focusing on producing a presentation including pictures, slide transitions, animations and effects. Our PE module will be fielding and striking, so we will be playing rounders and cricket for example. In Science we shall be working on learning about sound – what is a soundwave and how do they travel? We will also be developing our key skills using a scheme called Skills Builder as we look forward to our next steps in our *Adapting* module. In EHCP Target Time we shall be working on our independence in the community skills including hopefully using public transport this term. And finally in Maths this term, we shall be working on processing mathematical problems involving fractions, money, time, measurement and all four operations.

Maple pupils will also enjoy Food & Nutrition, Dance and Art with subject specialist teachers Alison, Chloe and Lily.
