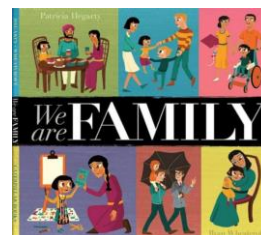

Curriculum

This term in maths we are going to be doing place value; sequencing, ordering and comparing numbers. We will also be using part, whole and using a number line. At the end of term, we will look at position and direction.

In literacy, we are going to be looking at the book 'We are Family'. This will be great for a cross-curricular link with PSHE and science. We will be looking at the structure of a sentence and looking at key vocabulary. Handwriting will be a key focus this term after such a long break.

In science we are going to be learning how to understand ourselves as well as looking at animals. We will investigate what humans and animals need to survive, looking specifically at healthy eating. We will also look at how we grow and change over time.

In PSHE we are looking at self-awareness and belonging, learning what it is like to be part of a team.
